In compliance with art. 17, items 1 and 2 of Law of 8 March 2013 on the Protection of Plants-
(Journal of Laws of 2017 item 50 with alt.) having reviewed the Application of 9 January-----
2018 complemented with letters of 9 February 2018 and 15 February 2018,-----

I hereby authorize Mr. Dariusz Gajek running Agro Research Consulting Dr. Dariusz Gajek
(ul. Nadburzańska 32, 99-400 Łowicz) to test the efficacy of the pesticides classified as:-----

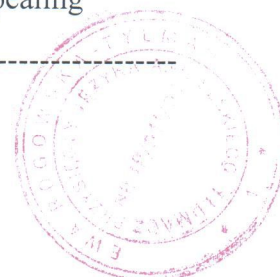
acaricides, bactericides, fungicides, herbicides, insecticides and semiochemicals in the arable
farming of cereals (winter wheat, spring wheat, triticale, rye, winter barley, spring barley,
oats), maize, winter rapeseed, spring rapeseed, vegetables (carrot, cucumber, cabbage, onion,
tomato, paprika), in th orchard cultivations of apple, pear, cherry, plum, sour cherry, black
currant, white/red currant, strawberry, raspberry, highbush blueberry), in the greenhouse
cultivations of vegetables (glasshouse cucumber, tomato) in the under roof cultivations and in
storage facilities (orchard plants – apples, pears).-----

-----JUSTIFICATION-----

By the letter of 9 January 2018, complemented with letters of 9 February and 15 February
2018, Mr Dariusz Gajek running Agro Research Consulting Dr. Dariusz Gajek (ul. -----
Nadburzańska 32, 99-400 Łowicz) applied to the General Inspector of Plants Protection and
Seed Production to authorize him to test the efficacy of plants protection products.-----

On 27 February 2018 in compliance with art. 17, item 6 of the Law of 8 March 2013 on the
Protection of Plants (Journal of Laws of 2017 item 50 with alt.) an inspection was carried out
within the compliance with requirements of Good Experimental Practice within the meaning
of art. 3, point 20 of European Parliament and Council (WE) Regulation no 1107/2009 of 21
October 2009 on the introduction of plants protection products to trading and repealing

Council Directives no 79/117 EWG and 91/414/EWG (Journal of Laws EU L 309 of 24.11.2009, page 1 with alt.) by Mr. Dariusz Gajek running Agro Research Consulting Dr. Dariusz Gajek.-----

The inspection report was made, in which identified weaknesses were listed referring to the storage room for plants protection products. The party committed to following the inspection recommendations and on 28 February and 1 March submitted to the General Inspector of

Plants Protection and Seed Production photographic documentation confirming the ----- implementation of inspection recommendations.-----

Given the above it can be stated that Mr. Dariusz Gajek running Agro Research Consulting Dr. Dariusz Gajek meets the requirements of Good Experimental Practice and it is decided as stated above.-----

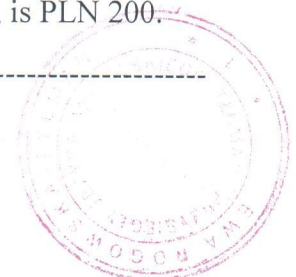
This Decision is not subject to appeal. However, if the party is not satisfied with this----- Decision, it may request the General Inspector of Plants Protection and Seed Production to reconsider the case within 14 days of the date this Decision is served, according to art. 127 § 3 of the Code of Administrative Proceedings.-----

During the period till resubmission of the application for another consideration, the party may waive this right to the public administration institution issuing the Decision. The Decision becomes effective and final on the day of service of waving this right to the General Inspector of Plants Protection and Seed Production, which means that the Decision shall have immediate effect and it is no subject to appeal to Regional Administrative Court.-----

However, if the party is not of the opinion that this Decision is consistent with his application and has no intention to use the right to reconsideration of the case, he may make a complaint on the Decision to Regional Administrative Court within 30 days of service. The complaint is submitted via General Inspector of Plants Protection and Seed Production.-----

In compliance with § 2, item 1, point 2 of Regulation of Council of Ministers of 16----- December 2003 on charges and details referring to entries in proceedings in administrative courts (Journal of Laws No 221, item 2193 with alt.) a permanent entry regardless of the subject matter of the contested act or activity in cases against acts or activities within public administration concerning duties and powers resulting from provisions of law, is PLN 200.-----

On application by th party submitted before the proceedings are initiated or in the course of the proceedings, the party may be granted aid in partial or complete exemption from court costs and appointing a barrister or legal advisor if the party proves unability to bear partial or complete costs of the proceedings.

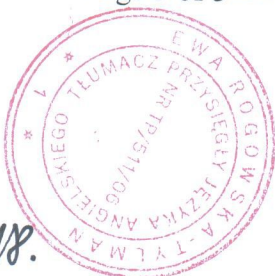
